OR
- Dependent child of *Current member* of **NGANH & NGAUS**
AND
- A high school senior or new continuing education student
- Currently enrolled College or Graduate Student or
- *Enrollment (or anticipated) in a fully accredited associate, baccalaureate, graduate, professional, or doctoral degree program required or*
- *Attendance status must be full time or part time greater than 2 courses per semester*
- NOTE: *Honorary or Corporate members do not meet the eligibility criteria!*
